ROTARY CLUB OF WEST EL PASO FOUNDATION UPDATE

We held the first meeting of the Rotary Club of West El Paso Foundation this past Monday. The foundation is the entity that manages the money for our charitable giving. Every year this helps support our recurring activities, notably the 4th of July parade, RYLA, Matching Grants, 3h grants, and holiday baskets. In addition, there have been various charities that we have supported from time to time, such as the Red Cross, the YMCA, and the El Paso Times literacy program. The only source of this money for the last seven years has been our golf tournament.



For those of you who are not aware, our foundation is a separate entity from the club and has its own board of directors, budget and bank accounts. So operational income and expenses, such as our dues, meal charges, payments to the Holiday Inn, and miscellaneous club expenses are club activities and are not related to any foundation activities. The foundation is for our charitable activities.

Mike Schmid, treasurer of the foundation reported that at this point, we have a little over \$30K in the foundation accounts. And, because of the conclusion of our golf tournament, the board voted to remove the restriction that we set aside a reserve for contingencies related to the golf tournament. This gives us the opportunity to allocate some money for projects. But we must all keep in mind that this is a limited resource, that we have recurring expenses, and we still face the task of defining our fundraising efforts that will drive future charitable activities.

The board did vote to fund some activities at this time, however. Specifically we discussed items which have been recurring and a part of our yearly activities. We voted to fund RYLA campers for next year at the same level that we have in the past. This has allowed us to send two boys and two girls to go to RYLA. We also voted to allocate \$3000 to a Matching Grant for this year. Chava will investigate potential projects for the board to review. We also voted to allocate \$500 to a 3H grant which can be used to support supplies for needy children. Other events which we do every year will be reviewed at a later meeting. These are holiday baskets and our 4th of July parade.

Looking to the future, we, as a club, must look to the ways that we will replenish the foundation funds so that we can continue to pursue these and other works that help us help others.

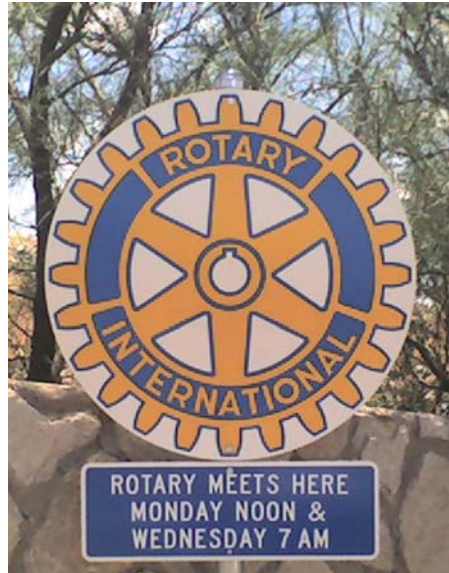
