West El Paso Rotary Santas Deliver for Candlelighters

In past holiday seasons, our Club has prepared food baskets for needy families in El Paso that were identified by the Candlelighters. This holiday season, Candlelighters asked us to take a different approach. They asked the Club to adopt twenty families from their facility and to fill the Christmas wish lists of the children. Led by Dana Vogelmeier, we have been busy filling gift lists for some forty-six children ranging in age from "0-16". Some of the children just wanted clothes, or a Barbie, race cars – some wanted a gift card or a CD. The Club will be delivering the gifts on December 18th as part of our regular Club meeting – twelve of our Club members have signed up to deliver packages.

Candlelighters was very happy with what we were able to achieve and for our efforts in helping their families. The El Paso Candlelighters is a non-profit support group that offers assistance to families of children with cancer. They currently have 700 families registered with them in the El Paso area.

Much of the regular meeting of the Rotary Club of West El Paso was devoted to final preparation of gifts that the Club purchased for the children of Candlelighters families. The Club granted the Christmas wishes of some forty children for this project.

About a dozen "Santas" from the Club volunteered to personally deliver the gifts to the children.
