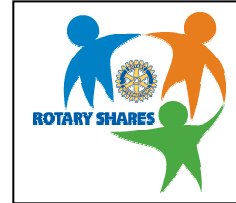

CLUB PERFECT ATTENDANCE AWARDS TO BE PRESENTED AT 10/29 MEETING

Regular attendance is important to the success of any endeavor, and the Rotary Club of West El Paso recognizes this too in the form of annual Club perfect attendance awards. This year some eight members will be recognized at this week's Club meeting for perfect attendance for Rotary year ending June 30, 2007. Leading this year's group of perfect attenders is Bill Mottinger who is rapidly approaching four decades of perfect attendance!

In our Rotary Club, perfect attendance can be achieved in several ways:

- A “natural” involves simply attending every scheduled Monday meeting of our Club – without forgetting to sign in at the registration table at the meeting!
- Via “make ups” – this is the most common method used by our perfect attenders, but a makeup should be done within 14 days before or after the usual time of the regular Club meeting; also the member should personally notify the Club, ideally the Club secretary, in writing of the makeup activity that she or he wants counted toward a make up. The Club is fairly generous in awarding activity as make up – typical make up venues are attendance at the regular meeting of another Rotary club; attendance at Club committee meeting or Club Board Meetings, or other Rotary work – such as working the Golf Tournament or Parade, Interact work, RYLA etc. The eClub venue has become increasingly popular with member – eClub allows a member to make up at anytime by going online. The Club secretary is automatically notified via email of this type of makeup activity.
- Exceptions for attendance requirements of course can be made for protracted ill health or impairment if approved by the Board and requested in writing by the member.
